



## Florida Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (FBCCEDP)

### Health Equity Project Pilot:

The Health Equity Pilot Project is designed to improve health equity in populations that are disproportionately burdened.

### Eligibility:

- ❖ Primary resident of Florida
- ❖ Reside in Pasco, Hernando, Sumter, or Citrus County
- ❖ Women Ages 40-49
- ❖ Uninsured or under-insured (catastrophic insurance or insurance does not cover breast or cervical screening)
- ❖ Have a household income less than or equal to 200 percent of the poverty level
- ❖ No breast symptoms (asymptomatic)
- ❖ Minority women, defined by race and ethnicity, women with low literacy or who speak little or no English, and women with disabilities

### Services provided free or low-cost:

- ❖ Clinical breast exam
- ❖ Screening mammogram
- ❖ Diagnostic follow up as needed
- ❖ Care coordination
