DOH-PASCO CLOSED ON JULY 5

Over 253,000 People Vaccinated in Pasco County

PASCO COUNTY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Health in Pasco County (DOH-Pasco) will be closed on Monday, July 5 in observance of Independence Day and will reopen on Tuesday, July 6.

DOH-Pasco encourages individuals who are attending celebrations this summer to follow CDC COVID-19 guidance for unvaccinated people while attending [large gatherings](#) and [small gatherings](#). The CDC also provides [guidance for fully vaccinated people](#).

As of Sunday, June 27, Pasco County has vaccinated 253,844 people: 32,484 people have received their first doses and 221,360 people have completed their second doses. The following are percentages in Pasco County as of June 30:

- **12-19 years old:** 26 percent have received at least one dose
- **20-64 years old:** 47 percent have received at least one dose
- **65+ years old:** 81 percent have received at least one dose

In addition, the seven-day COVID-19 positivity rate in Pasco County as of Wednesday, June 30 is 4.2 percent.

COVID-19 vaccination appointments are available Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. at our Dade City clinic at 13941 15th St. and at our New Port Richey clinic located at 10841 Little Rd.

To schedule an appointment for a COVID-19 vaccination at a DOH-Pasco clinic, individuals can call **727-861-5260** and select **Option 1** for Medical Services then **Option 2** for Immunizations. It is required to have a photo I.D. when checking in for all vaccination appointments.

Currently, DOH-Pasco only has the Moderna vaccine, which means DOH-Pasco is unable to provide vaccine to individuals who are 12-17 years old. However, Pasco County has over 130 locations providing vaccine throughout the county, and many of them offer the Pfizer vaccine.
