



Internship Tuition and Fees

There is no tuition for the WIC Track of the Pasco County Dietetic Internship however WIC Track interns will be required to sign a work service obligation agreement of 3,120 hours (State of Florida employees) or 4,160 hours (Non-State of Florida employees) prior to the start of the internship and work for a Florida Department of Health WIC Program location at the term of internship supervised practice. There is tuition for the PAL Track.

Participation in the Pasco County Health Department Dietetic Internship Program may allow college loans to be deferred. Also, because of the internship status, educational loans may be requested through the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (AND) or a lending institution. Seeking financial aid is the responsibility of the dietetic intern.

WIC Track dietetic interns receive their full-time salary and fringe benefits for 5 weeks during their WIC rotation from their sponsoring agency during the internship. Dietetic interns do not receive stipends in addition to their salaries provided by their employer. Interns must provide their own transportation.
