## This opportunity would could entail the following:

- 1. **Credit numbers**: The current program is a 35-credit program. All courses will be distance learning/online.
- 2. **Length of program**: 20 months. The MS program will start in the Spring. Students can expect to graduate in the summer of the second year. For example, if you start in Spring 2020 you can expect to graduate in Summer 2021.
- 3. **Application**: Flexible "fast track" application process. Students who are accepted into the internship would apply to the MS program via UNF graduate school in December and then start courses in January. GRE is waived.
