Health Equity Project Pilot:

The Health Equity Pilot Project is designed to improve health equity in populations that are disproportionately burdened.

Eligibility:

- Primary resident of Florida
- Reside in Pasco, Hernando, Sumter, or Citrus County
- ❖ Women Ages 40-49
- Uninsured or under-insured (catastrophic insurance or insurance does not cover breast or cervical screening)
- Have a household income less than or equal to 200 percent of the poverty level
- No breast symptoms (asymptomatic)
- Minority women, defined by race and ethnicity, women with low literacy or who speak little or no English, and women with disabilities

Services provided free or low-cost:

- Clinical breast exam
- Screening mammogram
- Diagnostic follow up as needed
- Care coordination
