



Moffitt Cancer Center to Offer Mobile Lung Cancer Screenings to Pasco County Residents

Florida Department of Health in Pasco County to host screening event from Nov. 12-14

WHO: Moffitt Cancer Center, the only National Cancer Institute-designated

Comprehensive Cancer Center based in Florida, is partnering with the Florida Department of Health in Pasco County to offer low-dose CT scans

inside Moffitt's new mobile lung screening unit.

WHAT: For the first time, Pasco County residents will be able to get screened for

lung cancer inside Moffitt Cancer Center's new mobile lung screening unit. <u>Lung cancer</u> is the leading cause of cancer deaths worldwide. More people die every year from the disease than from <u>prostate</u>, <u>breast</u> and <u>colon cancers</u> combined. The mobile lung screening unit, equipped with a low-dose CT machine, aims to revolutionize lung cancer detection and

prevention.

If you are over the age of 50 and are a current or former smoker, you may be eligible for screening. To find out if you qualify or to register, call 1-
