NALOXONE

WHAT IS NALOXONE?



Naloxone is a safe medication that immediately restores normal breathing in people overdosing on opioids. It is administered either by an injection or through a nasal spray.

First responders, friends, family, and bystanders can save lives with naloxone. You can be a first responder and save lives with naloxone.
