

Florida Department of Health in Pasco County Dietetic internship

Intent to Participate Form - UNF MS Degree

One of the admission requirements for the Florida Department of Health in Pasco County Dietetic Internship is having a master's degree or higher from a U.S. accredited institution* or having a bachelor's degree from a U.S. accredited institution* plus agreement to complete the University of North Florida (UNF) Nutrition and Dietetics (MS) Dietetic Professional Studies program concurrently with the internship.

Since the internship has a graduate level designation, we cannot provide a Dietetic Internship Verification Statement of Completion to interns without a graduate degree. If you agree to participate in the UNF graduate degree program, you must finish the program and earn your MS degree to meet the requirements for internship completion.

This "Intent to Participate Form" must be included in the application packet to identify candidates as either already having a master's degree or as intending to participate in the graduate program concurrently with the internship.
