# University of North Florida Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics Online Program – Condensed for Dietetic Internships

For interns who do not already have a graduate degree, the University of North Florida (UNF) provides them the opportunity to earn a Master of Science (MS) degree concurrently with the internship.

# Program:

- Credit hours: The program is 35 credit hours. Twenty-three of the credit hours satisfy UNF's
  Major Requirements for the MS in Nutrition and Dietetics program. The remaining 12 credit
  hours are earned through participation in the dietetic internship as Concentration
  Requirements.
- 2. **Location:** All courses are offered through distance learning online.
- 3. **Length of program**: Twelve (12) months. The MS program will start in the Summer B semester (June) prior to the internship and will end after Summer A semester (June) after the internship.
- 4. **Application**: Students who are accepted into the internship without a graduate degree must apply to the MS program via UNF graduate school by April 15th and start courses in June. Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) is waived for applicants coming to UNF through the internship. Letter of intent and recommendation letters are also waived when acceptance into the internship letter is provided instead.
