UNF MS Degree Intent to Participate Form

One of the admission requirements for the Florida Department of Health in Pasco County Dietetic Internship is having a master's degree or higher from a U.S. accredited institution **or** having a bachelor's degree from a U.S. accredited institution **plus** agreement to complete the UNF MS in Nutrition and Dietetics concurrently with the internship.

The "Intent to Participate Form" must be included in the application packet to identify candidates as either already having a master's degree or as intending to participate in the graduate program concurrently with the internship.

Starting with the Class of 2024, the internship cannot provide a Dietetic Internship Verification Statement of Completion to interns without a graduate degree. **Candidates agreeing to participate in the graduate degree program should be aware that they must also graduate from the program to graduate from the internship.**
