From the survey results DOH-Pasco along with community partners (Pasco County Long Range Planning, Pasco County Parks and Recreation, Keep Pasco Beautiful, Holiday Community Cares, and the Rotary Club of Holiday) are in the process of revamping a playground in Aloha Gardens Park.

Additional Park & playground components inside Aloha Gardens Park include: a dog park, rain garden, native plants, educational signage, and trees.

In conjunction with the Aloha Gardens Park, there have been several clean up and waste removals in the Holiday, FL. area. On September 9th, 2022, residents were offered to bring waste to the Pasco County Solid Waste Citizen's Drop Off at no charge.

On September 10th, 2022, Commissioner Kathryn Starkey hosted a curbside pickup community clean-up in the Buena Vista area with removal of 36 tons of waste.

Lastly, on March 4th, 2023, Pasco County Keep Pasco Beautiful hosted a Great American Cleanup where 28,957lbs, 14.48 tons of waste was removed in various locations of Holiday, FL.
