University of North Florida Master of Science in Nutrition and Dietetics Dietetic Professional Studies

If you do not already have a graduate degree, the University of North Florida (UNF) provides you with the opportunity to earn a Master of Science (MS) degree concurrently with the internship.

Recent and upcoming changes:

- The 2026-2027 class year is the last year in which interns can complete the UNF Dietetic Professional Studies program concurrently with the internship.
- The state employee tuition waiver is no longer accepted for use in the UNF Dietetic Professional Studies program.

Program:

1. **Credit hours:** The program is 30 credit hours.
2. **Location:** All courses are offered online.
3. **Length of program:** For full-time students, the program is three semesters beginning in fall semester (mid-August) and ending in the summer semester (early August). Interns can start the program prior to the internship if they want to reduce their course load during the internship by taking some classes early.
4. **Application:** Students who are accepted into the internship without a graduate degree must apply to the Nutrition and Dietetics (MS) Dietetic Professional Studies program at UNF. Application deadlines are December 1st for a spring semester start, April 15th for a summer semester start, and August 1st for a Fall semester start. Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) is waived for applicants coming to UNF through the internship. Letter of intent and recommendation letters are also waived when the acceptance into the internship letter is provided instead.
